Re: Request for Board Approval to Hire Cadets to Undergo Training

Recommendation

“That the Sarnia Police Services Board approves the appointments of Jeremy Wilde and Andrew Veale as police cadets to undergo training in accordance with section 51(1) of the Police Services Act.”

Background

The Ontario Police Services Act, 2017 Edition, section 51(1) states that;

“With the board’s approval, a municipal chief of police may appoint persons as police cadets to undergo training.”

The recent Civilian Collective Agreement between the Sarnia Police Service Board and the Sarnia Police Association Article 20:07 allows for the Chief of Police, subject to Board approval, to hire cadets to undergo training at the Ontario Police College.

The two identified persons have completed an extensive recruit identification process and are being recommended for appointments as cadets.

I have personally reviewed the recruit reports on the two candidates and agree that they be hired as cadets to undergo training.

Financial Implications

In accordance with Article 20:07 of the Civilian Collective Agreement, cadets are paid at a rate consistent with 50% of a First Class Constable and then, upon successful completion of the Basic Constable Training Program at the Ontario Police College, are sworn in as Fourth Class Constables.
